

CHARM SCRAPPY QUILT on POINT

Quilt Size 57" X 76", main body is 10 charm (5") squares by 14 charm (5") squares

Supplies:

4 Charm Packs with at least 35 charms per pack or 140- 5" Squares

Regular Borders:

1/2 yard fabric for inner border; Cut 2" strips

1 yard fabric for outer border; Cut 5" strips

1/2 yard fabric for binding; Cut 2-1/2" strips

Charm Border:

1/2 yard fabric for inner border

1 charm pack or 40-5" squares for outer border

1/2 yard fabric for binding

Instructions:

1. Sew blocks together with 1/4 inch seams to desired width.
2. Make as many rows as you need for the length you want your quilt to be.
3. Sew rows together to make the quilt body; pressing as you go.
4. Mark the top, bottom, left and right sides of the quilt.
5. Count number of blocks across the top of quilt, then count the same number of blocks on the left side. Make a diagonal cut from the middle of the last counted block on the left side to the upper right corner. 1st cut. (Diagram A).
6. Move the top piece to the bottom of the quilt and sew. (Diagram B).
7. From the bottom left edge, cut across to the right edge. Sew the bottom piece to the top matching the right and left sides together. (Diagram C).
8. Your quilt body is now on point. Add your inner border and outer border and quilt it! (Diagram D).
